CY2010 Annual Accomplishment Report

Major accomplishments/highlights:

- ✓ Facilitated the dropping from the Senate books of account <u>all</u> items that were donated/disposed of from 1997 to December 23, 2010 worth about P 133,485,058.26, per attached copy of the report (Doc. 068 dated December 23, 2010) submitted by the Legislative Accounting Service (LAS) marked as *Annex* "A" hereof.
- ✓ As of December 31, 2010, SDC facilitated the disposal/donation of about P 7,734,190.18 worth of unserviceable Senate properties to various government agencies and NGOs and its subsequent dropping from the Senate books of account.
- ✓ Passed 13 resolutions for the donation/disposal of various Senate properties.
- ✓ Facilitated the approval by the Commission on Audit (COA) of the Request for Relief from Accountability of former PPS Service Chief, Angelita del Rosario, for lost/damaged properties at the former Philippine Veteran's Bank (PVB) Building at the Port Area, Manila worth about P 1,589,480.68.
- ✓ Disposed of waste materials including damaged/expired supplies at the PPS Supply Warehouse by donating the same to S.E.N.A.D.O. in support of it's "Sagip Basura" project.

Dropping from the books of donated items

The Senate Disposal Committee (SDC) had 12 meetings in 2010. It passed 13 resolutions duly approved by the Office of the Senate President (OSP) for the donation/disposal of unserviceable equipment, supplies and materials, books and reference materials and vehicles to various government agencies and non-governmental organizations (NGOs).

From 1997 until December 31, 2010 the total worth of items disposed of/donated to other agencies is about P 133,485,058.26, based on acquisition cost. The same amount was dropped from the Senate books of account by the LAS per report submitted to the SDC dated December 23, 2010 marked as Document No. 068 (Annex "A"). But for CY2010, the total worth of items disposed of/donated to other agencies is about P 7,734,190.18.

The committee recognizes the joint efforts of the PPS and LAS in the dropping from the books of account of ALL donated items before the end of CY2010.



Properties at the former PhilippineVeteran's Bank (PVB) Building, Port Area, Manila

On June 23, 2009, the Committee passed SDC Resolution No. 2009-012 for the dropping from the Senate books of Senate properties that were lost/damaged at the former Philippine Veterans Bank (PVB) Building. Upon approval of said resolution by the Office of the Senate President, the same was submitted, together with pertinent documents, for evaluation and appropriate action to COA.

On December 15, 2010, the committee received a copy of National Government Sector (NGS) Cluster A Decision No. 2010-017 of COA granting the aforementioned request of Ms. Del Rosario for relief from accountability for lost/damaged properties located at the PVB, Bonifacio Drive, Port Area, Manila in the total amount of P 1,589,480.68.

Closing

For CY2010, the most notable of SDC's accomplishments are the dropping from the Senate books of **ALL ITEMS** that were disposed of/donated to other agencies from 1997 until December 31, 2010 and facilitating the request of Ms. Del Rosario for relief from accountability for lost/damaged Senate properties at the former PVB building. The committee recognizes the joint efforts of PPS and LAS in this endeavor.

In our desire to be able contribute in the effort to help save the environment, the SDC disposed of waste materials/supplies by donating the same to NGOs like the S.E.N.A.D.O. in support of their SAGIP BASURA Program. Other waste materials/supplies like tires were donated to a government hospital who was also a recipient of one of the Senate's unserviceable vehicles.
