# 2011 Accomplishment Report

## Major accomplishments/highlights:

- ✓ Facilitated the dropping from the Senate books of account a total of about P 138,018,707.02 worth of items that were donated/disposed of from 1997 to December 31, 2011 per attached copy of the report dated January 1, 2012 submitted by the Legislative Accounting Service (LAS) marked as *Annex* "A" hereof.
- ✓ As of December 31, 2011, SDC facilitated the disposal/donation of about P 4,533,648.76 worth of unserviceable Senate properties to various government agencies and its subsequent dropping from the Senate books of account.
- ✓ Passed seven (7) resolutions for the donation/disposal of various Senate properties to twenty (21) beneficiaries from four (4) government agencies in eight (8) regions all over the country.

#### Dropping from the books of donated items

The Senate Disposal Committee (SDC) had eight (8) meetings in 2011. It passed seven (7) resolutions duly approved by the Office of the Senate President (OSP) for the donation/disposal of unserviceable equipment, supplies and materials and vehicles to various government agencies.

From 1997 until December 31, 2011 the total worth of items disposed of/donated to other agencies based on acquisition cost is about P 138,018,707.02; out of said amount, about P 4,533,648.76 worth of the total items donated/disposed of in 2011 was dropped from the Senate books of account by the LAS per report submitted to the SDC dated January 1, 2012 (copy attached marked as Annex "A" hereof).


