



CITY AS PRESIDENT DIOSDADO P. MACAPAGAL BRIDGE"**


has considered the same and has the honor to report it back to the Senate with the





AN ACT NAMING THE NEWLY CONSTRUCTED BRIDGE IN BUTUAN
CITY AS PRESIDENT DIOSDADO P. MACAPAGAL BRIDGE

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. The newly constructed bridge in Butuan City is hereby
2 named as President Diosdado P. Macapagal Bridge.

3 SEC. 2. The Department of Public Works and Highways shall issue the
4 necessary rules, orders and circulars to implement the provision of this Act.

5 SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
6 in a newspaper of general circulation.
