





AN ACT RENAMING REAL STREET IN DUMAGUETE CITY AS
MAYOR RAMON TEVES PASTOR SR. STREET

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. The name of Real Street in Dumaguete City shall
2 hereinafter be known as Mayor Ramon Teves Pastor Sr. Street.

3 SEC. 2. The Department of Public Works and Highways shall issue the
4 necessary rules, orders and circulars to implement the provision of this Act.

5 SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
6 in a newspaper of general circulation.
