The Committee on Public Works, to which was referred House Bill No. 4795, introduced by Representative Roger G. Mercado, entitled:



has considered the same and has the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that it be approved with the following amendments.


1. On the bill title, replace the name "Diosdado Pangan Macapagal" by "**PRES. DIOSDADO P. MACAPAGAL**"; and

AN ACT RENAMING THE LILOAN BRIDGE IN THE LONE DISTRICT
OF SOUTHERN LEYTE AS DIOSDADO PANGAN MACAPAGAL
BRIDGE

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. The Liloan Bridge in the lone district of Southern Leyte
2 shall hereafter be known as Diosdado Pangan Macapagal Bridge.

3 SEC. 2. The Department of Public Works and Highways shall issue the
4 necessary rules, orders and circulars to implement the provision of this Act.

5 SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
6 in a newspaper of general circulation.
