
The Committee on Public Works, to which was referred House Bill No. 5392 introduced by Representative Jose G. Solis, entitled:





AN ACT NAMING THE PROVINCIAL ROAD FROM THE MUNICIPALITY OF STA. MAGDALENA UP TO PAWA ROAD IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MATNOG, PROVINCE OF SORSOGON AS GOV. JUAN G. FRIVALDO HIGHWAY

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. The provincial road from the Municipality of Sta.
2 Magdalena up to Pawa Road in the Municipality of Matnog, Province of
3 Sorsogon shall hereinafter be known as Gov. Juan G. Frivaldo Highway.

4 SEC. 2. The Department of Public Works and Highways shall issue the
5 necessary rules, orders and circulars to implement the provision of this Act.

6 SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
7 in a newspaper of general circulation.
