AN ACT CHANGING THE NAME OF LIBOTON STREET IN THE CITY
OF NAGA, PROVINCE OF CAMARINES SUR TO M.T.
VILLANUEVA AVENUE

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. The name of Liboton Street in the City of Naga, Province
2 of Camarines Sur shall hereinafter be known as M.T. Villanueva Avenue.

3 SEC. 2. The Department of Public Works and Highways shall issue the
4 necessary rules, orders and circulars to implement the provision of this Act.

5 SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
6 in a newspaper of general circulation.
