





AN ACT SEPARATING THE BUTIGUE NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL --
SAN RAFAEL ANNEX IN BARANGAY BANANAO,
MUNICIPALITY OF PARACELIS, MOUNTAIN PROVINCE FROM
THE BUTIGUE NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, CONVERTING IT
INTO AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE
KNOWN AS SAN RAFAEL NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

- 1 SECTION 1. *Separation and Conversion into a National High School.*
2 – The Butigue National High School – San Rafael Annex in Barangay
3 Bananao, Municipality of Paracelis, Mountain Province is hereby separated
4 from the Butigue National High School and converted into an independent
5 national high school to be known as San Rafael National High School.
6 SEC. 2. *Transfer of Assets and Liabilities.* – All personnel, assets,
7 liabilities and records of the Butigue National High School – San Rafael
8 Annex are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the San Rafael National High
9 School.

1 SEC. 3. *Appropriations.* – The Secretary of Education shall
2 immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of the
3 San Rafael National High School, the initial funding of which shall be charged
4 against the current year's appropriations of the Butigue National High School –
5 San Rafael Annex. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued
6 operation of the school shall be included in the annual General Appropriations
7 Act.

8 SEC. 4. *Implementation.* – The Secretary of Education shall issue rules
9 and regulations that may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

10 SEC. 5. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
11 its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
