Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Separation and Conversion into a National High School.

The Guinzadan National High School - Tapapan Annex in Barangay

Tapapan, Municipality of Bauko, Mountain Province is hereby separated from

the Guinzadan National High School and converted into an independent

national high school to be known as Tapapan National High School.

SEC. 2. Transfer of Assets and Liabilities. - All personnel, assets,

SEC. 2. Transfer of Assets and Liabilities. — All personnel, assets, liabilities and records of the Guinzadan National High School — Tapapan Annex are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Tapapan National High School.

1	SEC. 3. Appropriations The Secretary of Education shall
2	immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of the
3	Tapapan National High School, the initial funding of which shall be charged
4	against the current year's appropriations of the Guinzadan National High
5	School - Tapapan Annex. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued
6	operation of the school shall be included in the annual General Appropriations
7	Act.
8	SEC. 4. Implementation The Secretary of Education shall issue rules
9	and regulations that may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.
10	SEC. 5. Effectivity This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
11	its publication in the Official Gazette.
