



AN ACT SEPARATING THE TINOC NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL --
- WANGWANG ANNEX IN BARANGAY WANGWANG,
MUNICIPALITY OF TINOC, PROVINCE OF IFUGAO FROM THE
TINOC NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, CONVERTING IT INTO AN
INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS
KALANGUYA NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

- 1 SECTION 1. *Separation and Conversion into a National High School.*
2 - The Tinoc National High School - Wangwang Annex in Barangay
3 Wangwang, Municipality of Tinoc, Province of Ifugao is hereby separated
4 from the Tinoc National High School and converted into an independent
5 national high school to be known as Kalanguya National High School.
6 SEC. 2. *Transfer of Assets and Liabilities.* - All personnel, assets,
7 liabilities and records of the Tinoc National High School - Wangwang Annex
8 are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Kalanguya National High
9 School.

1 SEC. 3. *Appropriations.* – The Secretary of Education shall
2 immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of the
3 Kalanguya National High School, the initial funding of which shall be charged
4 against the current year's appropriations of the Tinoc National High School –
5 Wangwang Annex. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued
6 operation of the school shall be included in the annual General Appropriations
7 Act.

8 SEC. 4. *Implementation.* – The Secretary of Education shall issue rules
9 and regulations that may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

10 SEC. 5. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
11 its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
