CONCURRENT RESOLUTION No. 2

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION CREATING A JOINT COMMITTEE OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO NOTIFY THE PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES THAT CONGRESS, NOW CONVENED FOR ITS FIRST REGULAR SESSION OF THE FOURTEENTH CONGRESS OF THE PHILIPPINES, IS READY TO HEAR HER STATE OF THE NATION ADDRESS IN A JOINT SESSION OF BOTH HOUSES

Resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives of the Philippines concurring, That a Joint Committee of both Houses of Congress be created, composed of ten (10) members, five (5) to be appointed by the President of the Senate and five (5) to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, to notify the President of the Philippines that Congress, now convened for its First Regular Session of the Fourteenth Congress of the Philippines, is ready to hear her State of the Nation Address in a Joint Session of both Houses.
