RESOLUTION NO. 122

RESOLUTION COMMENDING HONORABLE
JUAN MIGUEL "MIGZ" F. ZUBIRI FOR HIS
EXCELLENT PERFORMANCE AND
OUTSTANDING LEADERSHIP AS SENATE
PRESIDENT DURING THE FIRST AND SECOND
REGULAR SESSIONS OF THE NINETEENTH
CONGRESS OF THE PHILIPPINES

WHEREAS, Senator Juan Miguel "Migz" F. Zubiri performed his duties and responsibilities as Senate President with utmost competence, dedication, fairness, and independence. During the First and Second Regular Sessions of the 19th Congress, he presided over floor deliberations of pending measures under an atmosphere of cooperation and mutual respect among senators from the majority and the minority;

WHEREAS, he was at the forefront in the united and courageous efforts of the members of the Senate to protect and defend the Constitution and the institution from all threats and attacks;

WHEREAS, throughout his leadership, he maintained his unbroken streak of perfect attendance that began during his first term as district representative in 1998, and he diligently presided over marathon sessions that ran late into the night, particularly during budget deliberations;

WHEREAS, under his watch, the Senate received some of its best approval and satisfaction ratings, perceived by the Filipino people as the last bastion of democracy, a resolute and independent institution always ready to protect democracy at any cost, and a compassionate body which patiently listens and acts on the need for decent jobs, equitable wages, and accessible health care;


