RESOLUTION NO. 17

RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING THE
METROBANK FOUNDATION OUTSTANDING

WHEREAS, the Metrobank Foundation Outstanding Filipinos is the most prestigious career-service award that honors the excellence, dedication, heroism and sacrifices of teachers, soldiers and police officers. 
