RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING THE PHILIPPINE TEAM FOR THEIR IMPRESSIVE PERFORMANCE DURING THE ASIAN PARA GAMES HELD ON OCTOBER 22 TO 28, 2023 IN HANGZHOU, CHINA

WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate has consistently recognized outstanding Filipinos who bring honor and glory to the nation through their remarkable feats and prestigious awards;

WHEREAS, the Asian Para Games is a multi-sport event for Asian athletes with disabilities. The latest edition was participated by more than 3,000 athletes from 44 countries, competing in 22 sports;

WHEREAS, Team Philippines' 72 athletes competed in archery, athletics, badminton, boccia, chess, cycling, judo, powerlifting, swimming, table tennis, taekwondo, and wheelchair basketball; WHEREAS, Team Philippines bagged an impressive medal haul of 19 - 10 gold, 4 silver, and 5 bronze.
