RESOLUTION No. 221

RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING  
MAKATI FC FOR BAGGING FOUR (4) TROPHIES  
AT THE CUP NO. 1 TOURNAMENT WHICH  
CONCLUDED ON JULY 14, 2023, IN  
FREDERIKSHAVN, DENMARK

WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate has consistently recognized outstanding Filipinos who bring honor and glory to the nation through their remarkable feats and prestigious awards;

WHEREAS, Makati FC made history by clinching the championship in the 39-year Cup No. 1 tournament held in Frederikshavn, Denmark, the first time that a youth club has swept the competition;

WHEREAS, Makati FC asserted their dominance in the Boys 11 division, securing a 3-0 victory against Denmark's Hobro IK in the finals. This victory marks Makati FC's first triumph in this category since 2015;

WHEREAS, the Boys 13 team also claimed the championship title by defeating Guatemala's Escuela La Academia FC, with a score of 6-5. This victory puts an end to the Boys 13 team's five-year wait for another title;

WHEREAS, the Girls 12/13 team, on the other hand, achieved a perfect record in their division, winning all six matches, including the 5-1 victory against Norway's Nord SK;

WHEREAS, the Girls 14 team also remained undefeated throughout their six matches, culminating in a dominant 3-0 triumph over the United States' San Francisco Seals;

WHEREAS, Makati FC's exceptional and remarkable performance, which led to the Philippines securing multiple trophies, deserves recognition and commendation for bringing pride and inspiration to the Filipino people: Now, therefore, be it


