RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING
ROBYN BROWN FOR CAPTURING THE
PHILIPPINES' FIRST GOLD MEDAL AT THE 2023
ASIAN ATHLETICS CHAMPIONSHIPS HELD IN
BANGKOK, THAILAND FROM JULY 12 TO 16, 2023

WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate has consistently recognized outstanding Filipinos who bring honor and glory to the nation through their remarkable feats and prestigious awards;

WHEREAS, 28-year-old Robyn Brown clinched the gold medal in the women's 400m hurdles at the 2023 Asian Athletics Championships held in Bangkok, Thailand;

WHEREAS, Brown ran the women's 400m hurdles final in 57.50 seconds, defeating the Japanese pair of Eri Utsunomiya (57.73) and Ami Yamamoto (57.80);

WHEREAS, this marks a significant milestone as the Philippines' first-ever gold medal in the said competition. Furthermore, Miss Brown's remarkable achievement also made her the first Filipina in 14 years to clinch the gold in the regional games;

WHEREAS, the exceptional and remarkable performance of Miss Brown deserves recognition and commendation for bringing pride and inspiration to the Filipino people: Now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the Senate of the Philippines, To congratulate and commend Robyn Brown for capturing the Philippines' first gold medal at the 2023 Asian Athletics Championships held in Bangkok, Thailand from July 12 to 16, 2023.


