## RESOLUTION No. 227

RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING THE PHILIPPINE TEAM UNDER THE JIU-JITSU FEDERATION OF THE PHILIPPINES FOR THEIR EXCEPTIONAL PERFORMANCE AND MEDAL HAUL IN THE 2024 JU-JITSU INTERNATIONAL FEDERATION (JJIF) WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS IN HERAKLION, GREECE

WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate has consistently recognized outstanding Filipinos who bring honor and glory to the nation through their remarkable feats and prestigious awards;

WHEREAS, the Ju-Jitsu International Federation (JJIF) is the international sport federation and global governing body for Jiu-Jitsu which oversees international competitions, sets rules and standards, and promotes and develops the sport worldwide; WHEREAS, the Jiu-Jitsu Federation of the Philippines (JJFP) is the National Sports Association for Jiu-Jitsu which leads the development of the sport in the country;

WHEREAS, the 2024 JJIF World Championships, held in Heraklion, Greece from 23 to 28 October for the adult division and 29 October to November 3 for the youth division, brought together over 780 elite martial artists from 58 nations competing in various categories in one of the most prestigious international competitions in the sport;

WHEREAS, the JJFP represented the Philippines and achieved the remarkable feat of winning a total of twenty (20) medals – eight (8) won by the youth team and twelve (12) won by the adult team. This is broken down into four (4) golds, two (2) silvers, and fourteen (14) bronzes, across different weight and age categories. The medalists were:
