FOR WINNING THE WOMEN'S DIVISION  
CHAMPIONSHIP AT THE RED BULL BUENOS  
AIRES CONQUEST HELD AT THE UNIVERSITY  
OF BUENOS AIRES LAW SCHOOL ON  
NOVEMBER 9, 2024

WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate has consistently recognized outstanding Filipinos who bring honor and glory to the nation through their remarkable feats and prestigious awards;

WHEREAS, a renowned Filipina skateboarder Margielyn Didal made a triumphant return to the global skateboarding

arena by capturing the title in the women's division at the Red Bull Buenos Aires Conquest in Argentina;


