





AN ACT ESTABLISHING A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY  
MINUYAN PROPER, CITY OF SAN JOSE DEL MONTE,  
PROVINCE OF BULACAN TO BE KNOWN AS MINUYAN  
NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS  
THEREFOR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in  
Congress assembled:*

1           SECTION 1. *Establishment of a National High School.* – There is  
2 hereby established, under the supervision of the Department of Education, a  
3 national high school in Barangay Minuyan Proper, City of San Jose Del  
4 Monte, Province of Bulacan to be known as Minuyan National High School.

5           SEC. 2. *Appropriations.* – The Secretary of Education shall  
6 immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of the  
7 Minuyan National High School, the funding of which shall be included in the  
8 annual General Appropriations Act.

9           SEC. 3. *Implementation.* – The Secretary of Education shall issue  
10 rules and regulations that may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this  
11 Act.

12           SEC. 4. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after  
13 its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
