AN ACT DECLARING EVERY 27TH DAY OF NOVEMBER AS "ARAW NG PAGBASA", A REGULAR WORKING HOLIDAY

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. *Title*. - This Act shall be known as "The Araw ng
Pagbasa Act of 2011".

3 SEC. 2. Declaration of Policy. – The State recognizes and supports 4 endeavors that promote reading and literacy, motivate awareness and uphold 5 our Filipino heritage and culture, including educational activities focusing on 6 the life of former Senator Benigno "Ninoy" Aquino Jr., whose role in our 7 country's history was influenced by great writings of different individuals.

8 The State likewise recognizes the importance of promoting reading as a 9 shared activity among the youth, families, educators and the private sector, 10 thereby emphasizing personal interaction and facilitating the exchange of ideas 11 throughout the country. SEC. 3. National Holiday. - November 27 of every year is hereby
declared as "Araw ng Pagbasa", which shall be a regular working holiday, to
be celebrated in all elementary and secondary schools in the country. In the
event that the holiday falls on a weekend, the holiday shall be observed on the
Friday of that week.

6 SEC. 4. *Implementing Agency.* – The Department of Education, in 7 consultation with the National Book Development Board, other government 8 agencies and units, and reading associations concerned, shall plan and 9 implement the activities for the observance of "Araw ng Pagbasa", such as` 10 story-telling sessions and reading skills modules. In addition to Filipino and 11 English, the use of regional languages in the celebration shall be encouraged.

SEC. 5. Effectivity. - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days upon
its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
