

1. On line 2 of page 1, delete the words "San Roque Annex" and in lieu thereof insert the words "Rolloqui and Reyes Annexes";
2. On lines 7 to 8 of the same page, delete the words "San Roque Annex" and in lieu thereof insert the words "Rolloqui and Reyes Annexes";
3. On line 5 of page 2, delete the words "San Roque Annex" and in lieu thereof insert the words "Rolloqui and Reyes Annexes"; and
4. On the title of the bill delete the words "SAN ROQUE ANNEX" and in lieu thereof insert the words "ROLLOQUI AND REYES ANNEXES" so that the title shall now read: "AN ACT SEPARATING THE ANTIPOLO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL-ROLLOQUI AND REYES ANNEXES IN BARANGAY SAN JUAN, CITY OF ANTIPOLO FROM ANTIPOLO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL CONVERTING IT INTO AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS SAN ROQUE NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR"







AN ACT SEPARATING THE ANTIPOLO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL –
SAN ROQUE ANNEX IN BARANGAY SAN ROQUE, CITY OF
ANTIPOLO FROM THE ANTIPOLO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL.
CONVERTING IT INTO AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH
SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS SAN ROQUE NATIONAL HIGH
SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Separation and Conversion into a National High School.*
2 – The Antipolo National High School – San Roque Annex in Barangay San
3 Roque, City of Antipolo is hereby separated from the Antipolo National High
4 School and converted into an independent national high school to be known as
5 San Roque National High School.

6 SEC. 2. *Transfer of Assets and Liabilities.* – All personnel, assets,
7 liabilities and records of the Antipolo National High School – San Roque
8 Annex are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the San Roque National High
9 School.

1 SEC. 3. *Appropriations.* – The Secretary of Education shall
2 immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of the
3 San Roque National High School, the initial funding of which shall be charged
4 against the current year's appropriations of the Antipolo National High School
5 – San Roque Annex. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued
6 operation of the school shall be included in the annual General Appropriations
7 Act.

8 SEC. 4. *Implementation.* – The Secretary of Education shall issue rules
9 and regulations that may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

10 SEC. 5. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
11 its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
