
The Committee on Public Works, to which was referred House Bill No. 5394, introduced by Representative Salvador H. Escudero, entitled:

BARANGAY DAO IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PILAR,
PROVINCE OF SORSOGON AS MAYOR MANUEL T. SIA
DIVERSION ROAD

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. The road network traversing Marifosque Street and
2 national highway at Barangay Dao in the Municipality of Pilar, Province of
3 Sorsogon shall hereinafter be known as Mayor Manuel T. Sia Diversion Road.

4 SEC. 2. The Department of Public Works and Highways shall issue the
5 necessary rules, orders and circulars to implement the provision of this Act.

6 SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
7 in a newspaper of general circulation.
