
The Committee on Public Works, to which was referred House Bill No. 5389, introduced by Representative Florencio T. Miraflores, entitled:

AN ACT RENAMING THE KALIBO -- NEW WASHINGTON ROAD IN
THE PROVINCE OF AKLAN AS JAIME CARDINAL SIN AVENUE

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. The Kalibo – New Washington Road in the Province of
2 Aklan shall hereinafter be known as Jaime Cardinal Sin Avenue.

3 SEC. 2. The Department of Public Works and Highways shall issue the
4 necessary rules, orders and circulars to implement the provision of this Act.

5 SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
6 in a newspaper of general circulation.
