





TRADES

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Renaming of High School.* – The name of San Narciso
2 Vocational High School in the Municipality of San Narciso, Province of
3 Quezon is hereby changed to Godofredo M. Tan Memorial School of Arts and
4 Trades.

5 SEC. 2. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
6 its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
