AN ACT SEPARATING THE BAGUIO CITY NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL

ROXAS ANNEX IN THE CITY OF BAGUIO FROM THE
BAGUIO CITY NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, CONVERTING IT
INTO AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE
KNOWN AS ROXAS NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. Separation and Conversion into a National High School. -2 The Baguio City National High School - Roxas Annex in the City of Baguio is hereby separated from the Baguio City National High School and converted 3 4 into an independent national high school to be known as Roxas National High 5 School. 6 SEC. 2. Transfer of Assets and Liabilities. - All personnel, assets, 7 liabilities and records of the Baguio City National High School - Roxas Annex 8 are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Roxas National High School. 9 SEC. 3. Appropriations. - The Secretary of Education shall

immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of the

1 Roxas National High School, the initial funding of which shall be charged 2 against the current year's appropriations of the Baguio City National High 3 School - Roxas Annex. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued operation of the school shall be included in the annual General Appropriations 4 5 Act. SEC. 4. Implementation. - The Secretary of Education shall issue rules 6 7 and regulations that may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act. 8 SEC. 5. Effectivity. - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after 9 its publication in the Official Gazette.
