





AN ACT SEPARATING THE HINGYON NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL  
ANNEX IN BARANGAY BITU, MUNICIPALITY OF HINGYON,  
PROVINCE OF IFUGAO FROM THE HINGYON NATIONAL HIGH  
SCHOOL, CONVERTING IT INTO A SEPARATE AND  
INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS  
SOUTHERN HINGYON NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND  
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in  
Congress assembled:*

- 1           SECTION 1. *Separation and Conversion into a National High School.*  
2    – *The Hingyon National High School Annex in Barangay Bitu, Municipality of*  
3    Hingyon, Province of Ifugao is hereby separated from the Hingyon National  
4    High School and converted into an independent national high school to be  
5    known as Southern Hingyon National High School.
- 6           SEC. 2. *Transfer of Assets and Liabilities.* – All personnel, assets,  
7    liabilities and records of the Hingyon National High School Annex are hereby  
8    transferred to and absorbed by the Southern Hingyon National High School.

1           SEC. 3. *Appropriations.* – The Secretary of Education shall  
2 immediately include in the Department’s program the operationalization of the  
3 Southern Hingyon National High School, the initial funding of which shall be  
4 charged against the current year’s appropriations of the Hingyon National High  
5 School Annex. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued operation  
6 of the school shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

7           SEC. 4. *Implementation.* – The Secretary of Education shall issue such  
8 rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

9           SEC. 5. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after  
10 its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
