- AN ACT CREATING AN ADDITIONAL REGIONAL TRIAL COURT BRANCH IN THE PROVINCE OF CAVITE TO BE STATIONED AT THE MUNICIPALITY OF CARMONA, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 14, PARAGRAPH (E) OF BATAS PAMBANSA BLG. 129, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "THE JUDICIARY REORGANIZATION ACT OF 1980", AS AMENDED, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby created an additional Regional Trial Court branch in the Fourth Judicial Region to be stationed at the Municipality of 2

- 3 Carmona. Province of Cavite.
- 4 The Supreme Court shall assign the branch number of the newly-created 5 Regional Trial Court branch in the Fourth Judicial Region.

SEC. 2. The jurisdiction over cases cognizable by the Regional Trial 7. Court under existing law, emanating from the municipalities of Carmona and Gen. Mariano Alvarez (G.M.A.) in the Province of Cavite, shall be lodged in

9 the Regional Trial Court branch created under this Act. 1 SEC. 3. The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, in coordination with 2 the Secretary of the Department of Justice, shall immediately include in the 3 Court's program the operationalization of an additional Regional Trial Court 4 branch to be stationed at the Municipality of Carmona, Province of Cavite, the 5 funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

6 SEC. 4. The Supreme Court shall issue the necessary rules and 7 regulations for the effective implementation of this Act and, if warranted, the 8 realignment of seats of existing branches and their territorial jurisdiction.

9 SEC. 5. Section 14(e) of Batas Pambansa Blg. 129, otherwise known as
10 "The Judiciary Reorganization Act of 1980", as amended, and all other laws,
11 rules and regulations which are inconsistent with this Act are hereby amended,
12 repealed or modified accordingly.

SEC. 6. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its complete
publication in the *Official Gazette* or in two (2) newspapers of general
circulation.
