AN ACT CONVERTING THE AGUINALDO HIGH SCHOOL IN
BARANGAY LUPAO, MUNICIPALITY OF AGUINALDO,
PROVINCE OF IFUGAO INTO A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO
BE KNOWN AS AGUINALDO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Conversion into a National High School.* – The Aguineldo
2 High School in Barangay Lupao, Municipality of Aguineldo, Province of
3 Ifugao is hereby converted into a national high school to be known as
4 Aguineldo National High School.

5 SEC. 2. *Transfer of Assets and Liabilities.* – All personnel, assets,
6 liabilities and records of the Aguineldo High School are hereby transferred to
7 and absorbed by the Aguineldo National High School.

8 SEC. 3. *Appropriations.* – The Secretary of Education shall
9 immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of the
10 Aguineldo National High School, the initial funding of which shall be charged
11 against the current year's appropriations of the Aguineldo High School.

1 Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued operation of the school
2 shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

3 SEC. 4. *Implementation.* – The Secretary of Education shall issue rules
4 and regulations that may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

5 SEC. 5. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
6 its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
