Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 Section 1. - The tenth day of Zhul Hijja, the twelfth month of the Islamic calendar, is hereby declared a national holiday. Eidul Adha is a tenth day in the 2 3 month of Hajj or Islamic Pilgrimage to Mecca wherein Muslims pay homage to Abraham's supreme act of sacrifice and signifies mankind's obedience to God. 4 5 Section 2. Section 26, Chapter 7 of Executive Order No. 292, Otherwise Known As The Administrative Code of 1987, as amended is hereby amended to read as 6 7 follows: "SEC. 26. Regular Holidays and Nationwide Special Days - (1) Unless 8 9 otherwise modified by law, order, or proclamation, the following regular holidays and special days shall be observed in the country: 10
