

AN ACT DECLARING ARNIS AS THE NATIONAL SPORT OF THE PHILIPPINES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. It is the policy of the State to inculcate patriotism, nationalism and appreciation of the role of national heroes and symbols in the historical development of the country. Furthermore, the State must give priority to education, science and technology, arts and culture, and sports to foster patriotism and nationalism, accelerate social progress, and promote total human liberation and development.

SECTION 2. Armis is hereby declared as the Philippine National Sport. The official adoption of armis as the national sport shall be promulgated by inscribing the symbol of armis in the official seal of the Philippine Sports Commission.

SECTION 3. The Department of Education and the Philippine Sports Commission shall promulgate the necessary rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of this Act.

SECTION 4. Any provision of law, decree, executive order, rule or regulation in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions and/or purposes of this Act is hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its complete publication in the Official Gazette or in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
