HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

BY REPRESENTATIVE SOON-RUIZ, PER COMMITTEE REPORT NO. 1137

AN ACT SEPARATING THE CITY OF LAPU-LAPU FROM THE SIXTH
LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT OF THE PROVINCE OF CEBU TO
CONSTITUTE THE LONE LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT OF THE
CITY OF LAPU-LAPU

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Lone Legislative District.* – The City of Lapu-lapu is
2 hereby separated from the Sixth Legislative District of the Province of Cebu to
3 constitute the Lone Legislative District of the City of Lapu-lapu, which shall
4 commence in the next national election after the effectivity of this Act.

5 SEC. 2. *Incumbent Representative.* – The incumbent representative of
6 the Sixth Legislative District of the Province of Cebu shall continue to
7 represent the said district until the new representative of the Lone Legislative
8 District of the City of Lapu-lapu shall have been elected and qualified.

9 SEC. 3. *Rules and Regulations.* – The Commission on Elections shall
10 issue the necessary rules and regulations to implement this Act.

1 SEC. 4. *Repealing Clause.* -- All laws, rules and regulations
2 inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed, amended or modified
3 accordingly.

4 SEC. 5. *Effectivity.* -- This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
5 its publication in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
