AN ACT SEPARATING THE MANAT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL –
KAO ANNEX IN BARANGAY KAO, MUNICIPALITY OF
NABUNTURAN, PROVINCE OF COMPOSTELA VALLEY FROM
THE MAIN MANAT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL CONVERTING
IT INTO AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE
KNOWN AS KAO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION I. Separation and Conversion into a National High School.

The Manat National High School - Kao Annex in Barangay Kao,

Municipality of Nabunturan, Province of Compostela Valley is hereby

separated from the Main Manat National High School and converted into an independent national high school to be known as Kao National High School.

SEC. 2. Transfer of Assets and Liabilities. - All personnel, assets,

7 liabilities at direcords of the Mirra Phyticiaal High School - Kao Armax are

hereby hansfured to and absorbed by the Kao National High School.

- 1	SEC. 3. Appropriations The Secretary of Education shall
2	immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of the
3	Kao National High School, the initial funding of which shall be charged
4	against the current year's appropriations of the Manat National High School -
5	Kao Annex. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued operation of
6	the school shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.
7	SEC. 4. Implementation The Secretary of Education shall issue rules
8	and regulations that may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.
9.	SEC. 5. Effectivity This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
10	its publication in the Official Gazette.
