AN ACT DECLARING DECEMBER 2 OF EVERY YEAR AS A SPECIAL NONWORKING HOLIDAY IN PASAY CITY TO BE KNOWN AS THE "FOUNDATION DAY OF PASAY CITY"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. December 2 of every year is hereby deciared as a special nonworking holiday in Pasay City to be known as the "Foundation Day of 3 Pasay City".

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
