Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. June 23 of every year is hereby declared as a special
nonworking holiday in the City of Tandag, Province of Surigao del Sur to be
known as the "Charter Day of Tandag City".

- 4 SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
- 5 in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation. Approved,
