




MR. PRESIDENT:





AN ACT DECLARING MAY 22 OF EVERY YEAR AS A SPECIAL
NONWORKING HOLIDAY IN THE PROVINCE OF GUIMARAS
TO COMMEMORATE ITS ANNIVERSARY

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. May 22 of every year is hereby declared as a special
2 nonworking holiday in the Province of Guimaras in commemoration of its
3 anniversary as a province.

4 SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
5 in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
