


have considered the same and have the honor to report them back to the Senate with the recommendation that the attached bill, Senate Bill No. 3006, prepared by the Committee, entitled:

**AN ACT**  
**DECLARING NOVEMBER 20 OF EVERY YEAR AS NATIONAL CHILDREN'S DAY**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 **SECTION 1.** This Act shall be known as the "*National Children's Day Act.*"

2 **SECTION 2.** November 20 of every year is hereby declared as the "National  
3 Children's Day" to promote consciousness over the protection of the rights of  
4 Filipino children and the importance of fostering their well-being to secure the  
5 growth and development of society.

6 This declaration shall likewise commemorate the United Nations  
7 General Assembly Ratification of the Convention on the Rights of the Child  
8 and in recognition of the United Nations celebration of Universal Children's  
9 Day.

10 **SECTION 3.** Pursuant to the observance of the National Children's Day, an  
11 annual program of activities shall be prepared and implemented with the  
12 Department of Education (DepEd), Department of Social Welfare and

1 Development (DSWD), the National Youth Commission (NYC) and the  
2 Council for the Welfare of Children (CWC) as lead agencies.

3 The Department of Education (DepEd) shall facilitate and encourage  
4 the commemoration of this day in all schools, public and private, nationwide.  
5 The Philippine Information Agency (PIA), in coordination with the DSWD,  
6 DepEd, CHED, NYC and CWC shall ensure the effective information  
7 dissemination of this Act.

8 **SECTION 4.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in  
9 at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation or in the *Official Gazette*.
