AN ACT CONVERTING THE NAAWAN BARANGAY HIGH SCHOOL IN
BARANGAY LINANGKAYAN, MUNICIPALITY OF NAAWAN,
PROVINCE OF MISAMIS ORIENTAL INTO A NATIONAL HIGH
SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS NAAWAN NATIONAL HIGH
SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Conversion into a National High School.* – The Naawan
2 Barangay High School in Barangay Linangkayan, Municipality of Naawan,
3 Province of Misamis Oriental is hereby converted into a national high school
4 to be known as Naawan National High School.

5 SEC. 2. *Transfer of Assets and Liabilities.* – All personnel, assets,
6 liabilities and records of the Naawan Barangay High School are hereby
7 transferred to and absorbed by the Naawan National High School.

8 SEC. 3. *Appropriations.* – The Secretary of Education shall
9 immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of the
10 Naawan National High School, the funding of which shall be included in the
11 annual General Appropriations Act.

1 SEC. 4. *Implementation.* – The Secretary of Education shall issue rules
2 and regulations that may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

3 SEC. 5. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
4 its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
