





AN ACT ESTABLISHING A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY
MATALANG, MUNICIPALITY OF MIDSALIP, PROVINCE OF
ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR TO BE KNOWN AS MATALANG
NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS
THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Establishment of a National High School.* – There is
2 hereby established, under the supervision of the Department of Education, a
3 national high school in Barangay Matalang, Municipality of Midsalip,
4 Province of Zamboanga del Sur to be known as Matalang National High
5 School.

6 SEC. 2. *Appropriations.* – The Secretary of Education shall
7 immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of the
8 Matalang National High School, the funding of which shall be included in the
9 annual General Appropriations Act.

10 SEC. 3. *Implementation.* – The Secretary of Education shall issue
11 rules and regulations that may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this
12 Act.

13 SEC. 4. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
14 its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
