

MR. PRESIDENT:

The Committee on Local Government, to which was referred House Bill No. 4729, introduced by Representative Erineo S. Maliksi, entitled:

"AN ACT

CONVERTING THE MUNICIPALITY OF IMUS IN THE PROVINCE OF CAVITE INTO A COMPONENT CITY TO BE KNOWN AS THE CITY OF IMUS"

taking into consideration Senate Bill No. 2761, introduced by Senator Panfilo M. Lacson, entitled:

"AN ACT

CONVERTING THE MUNICIPALITY OF IMUS IN THE PROVINCE OF CAVITE INTO A COMPONENT CITY TO BE KNOWN AS THE CITY OF IMUS"

has considered the same and has the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that it be approved with the following amendments:

- 1. On page 65, line 15 delete the phrase ": *Provided*, That the Province of Cavite shall continue to receive its share in real property taxes within two(2) years after commencement of corporate existence of the City";
- 2. On the same page, delete lines 19 to 25 and in lieu thereof insert the following as the new Section 65:

"Section 65. *Representative District.* – Upon its creation, the City of Imus shall maintain its status as the Third Legislative District of the Province of Cavite pursuant to Republic Act No. 9727."
