

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY  
MAYO, CITY OF MATI, PROVINCE OF DAVAO ORIENTAL TO  
BE KNOWN AS MAYO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND  
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in  
Congress assembled:*

1           SECTION 1. *Establishment of a National High School.* — There is  
2 hereby established, under the supervision of the Department of Education, a  
3 national high school in Barangay Mayo, City of Mati, Province of Davao  
4 Oriental to be known as Mayo National High School.

5           SEC. 2. *Appropriations.* — The Secretary of Education shall  
6 immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of  
7 Mayo National High School, the funding of which shall be included in the  
8 annual General Appropriations Act.

9           SEC. 3. *Implementation.* — The Secretary of Education shall issue such  
10 rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

11           SEC. 4. *Effectivity.* — This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after  
12 its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
