





AN ACT CONVERTING THE HINAWANAN HIGH SCHOOL IN
BARANGAY HINAWANAN, MUNICIPALITY OF LOAY,
PROVINCE OF BOHOL INTO A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO
BE KNOWN AS HINAWANAN NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

- 1 SECTION 1. *Conversion into a National High School.* – The
2 Hinawanan High School in Barangay Hinawanan, Municipality of Loay,
3 Province of Bohol is hereby converted into a national high school to be known
4 as Hinawanan National High School.
- 5 SEC. 2. *Transfer of Assets and Liabilities.* – All personnel, assets,
6 liabilities and records of the Hinawanan High School are hereby transferred to
7 and absorbed by the Hinawanan National High School.
- 8 SEC. 3. *Appropriations.* – The Secretary of Education shall
9 immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of the
10 Hinawanan National High School, the initial funding of which shall be charged
11 against the current year's appropriations of the Hinawanan High School.

1 Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued operation of the school
2 shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

3 SEC. 4. *Implementation.* -- The Secretary of Education shall issue rules
4 and regulations that may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

5 SEC. 5. *Effectivity.* -- This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
6 its publication in the *Official Gazette*.
