



**RESOLUTION**

**CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING FILIPINO POWERLIFTER ERLINDA PECANTE FOR WINNING FOUR INDIVIDUAL GOLD MEDALS IN THE WOMEN'S 90-KILOGRAM DIVISION OF THE 2009 WORLD MASTERS POWERLIFTING CHAMPIONSHIPS HELD IN OSTRAVA, CZECH REPUBLIC ON 27 SEPTEMBER – 3 OCTOBER 2009.**

**WHEREAS**, the Philippine Senate has in several occasions paid tribute to outstanding Filipino athletes for their astonishing feat of bringing home pride and glory to the country by becoming champions in international sporting competitions;

**WHEREAS**, World champion Filipina lifter Erlinda Pecante made the country proud when she won her fifth straight world title and her sixth overall in the 90-kilogram division of the 2009 World Masters Powerlifting Championships held in Ostrava, Czech Republic on 27 September – 3 October 2009;

**WHEREAS**, Erlinda Pecante who boasts of 27 national records and 10 Asian marks since starting to compete internationally bagged three individual gold medals in the squat (200kg), bench press (112.5kg) and deadlift (190kg), and another gold in the total lift (502.5 kg);

**WHEREAS**, by emerging victorious in this athletic event, Erlinda Pecante has made our country proud and has shown to the world the spirit of Filipino competitiveness and excellence;

**WHEREAS**, this outstanding performance by our Filipino powerlifter deserves to be commended for the honor and recognition she has brought to our country.
