

RESOLUTION

CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING FILIPINO POWERLIFTER ANTONIO TAGUIBAO FOR WINNING THREE INDIVIDUAL GOLD MEDALS AND A SILVER MEDAL IN THE MEN'S 56-KILOGRAM DIVISION OF THE 2009 WORLD MASTERS POWERLIFTING CHAMPIONSHIPS HELD IN OSTRAVA, CZECH REPUBLIC ON 27 SEPTEMBER – 3 OCTOBER 2009.

WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate has in several occasions paid tribute to outstanding Filipino athletes for their astonishing feat of bringing home pride and glory to the country by becoming champions in international sporting competitions;

WHEREAS, Filipino lifter Antonio Taguibao made the country proud when he claimed his sixth world title in the men's 56-kilogram division of the 2009 World Masters Powerlifting Championships held in Ostrava, Czech Republic on 27 September – 3 October 2009;

WHEREAS, Antonio Taguibao bagged three individual gold medals in the squat (177.5kg), deadlift (180kg) and total lifts (445kg), and a silver medal in the benchpress (87.5kg);

WHEREAS, by emerging victorious in this athletic event, Antonio Taguibao has made our country proud and has shown to the world the spirit of Filipino competitiveness and excellence;

WHEREAS, this outstanding performance by our Filipino powerlifter deserves to be commended for the honor and recognition he has brought to our country.
