RESOLUTION

CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING FILIPINA BOXER JOSIE GABUCO FOR WINNING THE GOLD MEDAL IN THE 7^{TH} AIBA WOMEN'S WORLD BOXING CHAMPIONSHIPS HELD ON 9 TO 20 MAY 2012 IN QINHUANGDAO, PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA.
