The Senate Committees on Public Services and on Finance, to which was referred H. B. No. 283, introduced by Representatives Golez, Mercado and Abaya, entitled:



AN ACT CONVERTING THE LAND TRANSPORTATION OFFICE (LTO)  
EXTENSION OFFICE LOCATED IN PARAÑAQUE CITY INTO A  
REGULAR LTO DISTRICT OFFICE, APPROPRIATING FUNDS  
THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in  
Congress assembled:*

1           SECTION 1. The existing Land Transportation Office (LTO) Extension  
2 Office located in Parañaque City is hereby converted into a regular LTO  
3 District Office.

4           SEC. 2. The Secretary of the Department of Transportation and  
5 Communications shall issue rules and regulations necessary for the effective  
6 implementation of this Act.

7           SEC. 3. The Secretary of Transportation and Communications shall  
8 immediately include in the Department's programs the operationalization of  
9 the LTO District Office in Parañaque City, the initial funding of which shall be  
10 charged against the current year's appropriations of the Parañaque City LTO  
11 Extension Office. Thereafter, such sums as may be necessary for the continued

1 implementation of this Act shall be included in the annual General  
2 Appropriations Act.

3 SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days following the  
4 completion of its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in two (2) national  
5 newspapers of general circulation.
