EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill seeks to institutionalize and expand the definitions of basic necessities and prime commodities while giving flexibility in their respective coverage to hasten implementation.

With this, it is submitted that the policy declared under Republic Act No. 7581 will be further realized. The apparent complexities in balancing availability of basic necessities and prime commodities at reasonable prices at all times and to ensure fair return of investment to legitimate businesses can be better addressed by the concerned implementing agencies of government given their expertise and institutional existence under well-established statutory standards and criteria.

Moreover, the consumers protection envisioned to be effective and sufficient against hoarding, profiteering and cartels, especially during times of calamity and emergency is enhanced through the inclusion of other goods deemed to be necessities under present time, which can now be expanded administratively without need of legislative enactment.

In view of the foregoing, immediate passage of this proposed measure is sought.

AN ACT

AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7581, ENTITLED "AN ACT PROVIDING PROTECTION TO CONSUMERS BY STABILIZING THE PRICES OF BASIC NECESSITIES AND PRIME COMMODITIES AND BY PRESCRIBING MEASURES AGAINST UNDUE PRICE INCREASES DURING EMERGENCY SITUATIONS AND LIKE OCCASIONS"

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Republic of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3(1) of Republic Act No. 7581, otherwise known as 2 the "Price Act", is hereby amended to read as follows: 3 4 "Sec. 3. Definition of Terms. - For purposes of this Act, the 5 term: "(1) "Basic necessities" [includes:] ARE GOODS VITAL TO 6 7 THE NEEDS OF CONSUMERS FOR THEIR SUSTENANCE AND EXISTENCE IN TIMES OF ANY OF THE CASES PROVIDED 8 9 UNDER SECTIONS 6 OR 7 OF THIS ACT SUCH AS, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, rice, corn, ROOT CROPS, bread; fresh, dried [and] 10 OR canned fish and other marine products[,]; fresh pork, beef and 11 poultry meat; fresh eggs; POTABLE WATER IN CONTAINERS; 12 fresh and processed milk; fresh vegetables AND FRUITS; [root 13 crops; NOODLES; coffee; sugar; cooking oil; salt; laundry soap [;] 14 AND detergents; firewood; charcoal; HOUSEHOLD LIQUEFIED 15 PETROLEUM GAS (LPG) AND KEROSENE; candles; [and] drugs 16 classified as essential by the Department of Health AND SUCH 17 OTHER GOODS AS MAY BE INCLUDED UNDER SECTION 4 18 OF THIS ACT;" 19 20 21 SEC.2. "(8) "Prime commodities" [include] ARE GOODS NOT CONSIDERED AS BASIC NECESSITIES BUT ARE ESSENTIAL TO CONSUMERS IN TIMES OF ANY OF THE CASES PROVIDED UNDER SECTION 7 OF THIS ACT SUCH AS, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, [fresh fruits;] flour; dried processed [and] OR canned pork[;], beef and poultry meat; dairy products not falling basic necessities[; noodles]; onions[;], garlic[:], vinegar[;],patis[;], soy sauce; toilet soap; fertilizer[;], pesticides[;] AND herbicides; poultry[;],[swine and cattle] LIVESTOCK AND FISHERY feeds[;] AND veterinary products [for poultry, swine and cattle]; paper; school supplies; nipa shingles; sawali; cement; sheets; hollow GI blocks; plywood; plyboard; construction nails; batteries; electrical supplies; light bulbs; steel wire; [and] all drugs not classified as essential drugs by the Department of Health AND SUCH OTHER GOODS AS MAY BE INCLUDED UNDER SECTION 4 OF THIS ACT."

SEC. 3. Section 4 of Republic Act No. 7581 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 4. INCLUSION OR Exclusion from the Coverage of this Act. - Upon petition of the concerned parties OR BY ACTION OF THE CONCERNED AGENCY OF THE PRICE COORDINATING COUNCIL MOTU PROPRIO and after public hearing, the implementing agency, with the approval of the President, MAY INCLUDE IN THE DEFINITION OF BASIC NECESSITIES OR PRIME COMMODITIES **TYPES** BRANDS OF THE GOODS OR may exclude from the coverage of this Act, types or brands of the goods included in the definition of basic necessities and prime commodities, which may be deemed as nonessential goods or luxury goods: Provided, That, any type or brand so excluded may be reinstated by the implementing agency during occasions of acute shortage in the supply of the basic necessity or prime commodity to which the excluded type or brand used to belong."

SEC. 4. Implementing Rules and Regulations. - The Department of Trade and Industry shall, in consultation with the members of the Price Coordinating Council and stakeholders, promulgate the necessary rules, regulations and procedures for the effective implementation of this Act within ninety (90) days from its effectivity. It shall likewise monitor strict compliance of this Act and review the existing implementing rules and regulations of Republic Act No. 7581 and revise its provisions as may be appropriate.

SEC. 5. Repealing Clause. – All laws, rules and regulations or part thereof contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SEC. 6. Separability Clause. – If any part of this Act is declared unconstitutional or invalid, such parts or provisions hereof not so declared shall remain valid and subsisting.

53 54 SEC. 7. Effectivity. – This Act shall take effect immediately following its complete publication in the Official Gazette or two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
