## EXPLANATORY NOTE

It mandates the Department of Labor and Employment (Dole) to promulgate the implementing rules and regulations of this measure declaring the Chinese New Year as a special non-working holiday in consultation with the Federation of Filipino-Chinese Chambers of Commerce and Industry.

Passage of this measure is earnestly sought.
