AN ACT

AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8048, ENTITLED "AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF THE CUTTING OF COCONUT TREES, ITS REPLENISHMENT, PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. Section 4 of Republic Act No. 8048, also known as the "Coconut Preservation Act of 1995", is hereby amended to read as follows: 2 "SEC. 4. Prohibition. - No coconut tree shall be cut except in the 3 4 following cases and only after a permit had been issued therefor: a) When the tree is sixty (60) years old IN THE CASE OF TALL 5 VARIETIES, AND AT LEAST FORTY (40) YEARS OLD FOR DWARF VARIETIES; 6 7 b) When the tree is no longer economically productive; c) When the tree is SEVERELY disease-infested AND BEYOND 8 **REHABILITATION;** 9 10 d) When the tree is SEVERELY damaged by typhoon or lightning; e) When the agricultural land devoted to coconut production shall 11 have been converted in accordance with law into residential, commercial or 12 industrial areas; 13 f) When the land devoted to coconut production shall be converted 14 into other agricultural uses or other agriculture-related activities in 15 pursuance to a conversion duly applied for by the owner and approved by 16 the proper authorities: Provided, That no conversion shall be allowed by the 17 PCA until after it shall have been verified and certified that for a period of at 18 least three (3) years the majority of the coconut trees have become 19 senescent and economically unproductive or where the coconut farm is not 20 adaptable to sound management practices on account of geographical 21 location, topography, drainage and other conditions rendering the farm 22 economically unproductive; and 23

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g) When the tree would cause hazard to life and property.

No other causes other than those abovementioned shall be considered as a valid ground for cutting."

- SEC. 2. Section 5 of Republic Act No. 8048 is hereby amended to read as follows:
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"SEC. 5. *Permit to Cut.* – No coconut tree or trees shall be cut unless a permit therefore, upon due application being made, has been issued by the PCA pursuant to Section 6 of this Act.

The applicant shall pay an application fee in the amount of [Twenty-8 five pesos (P25.00)] ONE HUNDRED PESOS (P100.00) for every tree 9 intended to be cut payable to the PCA. [Ten pesos (P10.00)] FORTY PESOS 10 (P40.00) of the fee shall accrue in favor of the PCA, [Ten pesos (P10.00)] 11 FORTY PESOS (P40.00) in favor of the municipal government concerned, 12 and [Five pesos (P5.00)] TWENTY PESOS (P20.00) in favor of the barangay 13 unit concerned. The fees ALLOCATED TO THE PCA shall be used for [the 14 PCA's] ITS replanting program and THE FEES ALLOCATED TO THE 15 MUNICIPAL/CITY GOVERNMENT SHALL BE USED for the repair and 16 rehabilitation of roads of the respective local government units which have 17 been damaged by the continuous passage of heavy vehicles used for 18 transporting coconut lumber, AND OF MUNICIPAL FARM-TO-MARKET 19 ROADS. 20

FEES HEREIN COLLECTED SHALL BE DEPOSITED WITH THE NEAREST LAND BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES BRANCH OR OTHER GOVERNMENT DEPOSITORY BANKS. FEES ACCRUING TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT SHALL BE REMITTED WITHIN THREE (3) MONTHS IN ACCORDANCE WITH EXISTING COMMISSION ON AUDIT (COA) RULES AND REGULATIONS.

No permit to cut shall be granted unless the applicant[, in coordination with the PCA and the local government unit concerned,] HAS SECURED FROM THE BARANGAY CAPTAIN, OF THE LOCALITY WHERE THE CUTTING WILL BE DONE, A CERTIFICATION UNDER OATH THAT HE/SHE has already planted the equivalent number of coconut trees applied for to be cut.

Such replanting[s], however, shall not apply to areas converted into industrial, commercial or residential sites or land transformed in accordance with law, into other agricultural purposes.

The PCA, in coordination with the local government unit concerned, shall **VERIFY IF A REPLANTING WAS IMPLEMENTED AND** regulate and oversee the [planting,] fertilization and care of the newly planted coconut trees. For this purpose, it shall be incumbent upon the PCA to conduct, from time to time, on-the-spot inspections of the sites where the coconut trees have been planted."

41 SEC. 3. A new Section 7 is hereby inserted after Section 6 of this Act, to read as

42 follows:

1"SEC. 7. POLICE POWERS. - THE PCA SHALL BE VESTED WITH THE2AUTHORITY TO EXERCISE DULY DELEGATED POLICE POWERS FOR THE3PROPER PERFORMANCE OF ITS FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES, TO WIT:

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A) INVESTIGATE SUSPECTED VIOLATIONS OF THIS ACT;

5 B) ARREST AND APPREHEND ANY PERSON ACTUALLY 6 COMMITTING OR ATTEMPTING TO COMMIT AN OFFENSE UNDER THIS 7 ACT;

8 C) ARREST AND APPREHEND POSSESSOR OF COCONUT LUMBER 9 WITHOUT THE NECESSARY PERMIT AS REQUIRED UNDER THIS ACT;

10D) SEARCH AND SEIZE A MOVING VEHICLE WITH ILLEGALLY CUT,11GATHERED, COLLECTED OR REMOVED COCONUT LUMBER: PROVIDED,12THAT PROBABLE CAUSE FOR THE SEARCH IS ESTABLISHED;

13E) STOP THE TRANSPORT AND/OR SHIPMENT OF COCONUT14LUMBER WITHOUT AUTHORITY OR WITHOUT LEGAL DOCUMENTS IN15ACCORDANCE WITH PERTINENT LAWS, REGULATIONS OR POLICIES ON THE16MATTER;

17F) CONFISCATE AND FORFEIT IN FAVOR OF THE GOVERNMENT THE18ILLEGALLY CUT, GATHERED, COLLECTED, REMOVED, POSSESSED OR19ABANDONED COCONUT LUMBER, AS WELL AS THE MACHINERY,20EQUIPMENT, IMPLEMENTS AND TOOLS ILLEGALLY USED IN THE21COMMISSION OF THE OFFENSE AND TO DISPOSE OF THE SAME IN22ACCORDANCE WITH PERTINENT LAWS, REGULATIONS OR POLICIES ON THE23MATTER; AND

24G) SEEK THE ASSISTANCE OF OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT25AGENCIES FOR THE EFFICIENT AND EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS26ACT."

27 SEC. 4. Section 7 of Republic Act No. 8048, hereby renumbered as Section 8, is

28 hereby amended to read as follows:

"SEC. [7]8. Implementing Rules. - The Philippine Coconut Authority
shall be the lead agency to implement the provisions of this Act. For this
purpose, the Philippine Coconut Authority shall prescribe the necessary
rules and regulations for the immediate and effective implementation of
this Act.

The PCA, in order to effectively implement the provisions of this Act, 34 may request the assistance of any local government unit, to monitor and 35 ensure compliance with this Act including its implementing rules and 36 regulations. For this purpose, the PCA may deputize the Philippine National 37 Police or other law enforcement agencies to investigate and apprehend 38 those caught violating the provisions of this Act, including the confiscation 39 of illegally cut coconut trees. IN ORDER TO PREVENT WASTAGE, THE PCA 40 SHALL ORDER THE IMMEDIATE DISPOSITION OF CONFISCATED COCONUT 41 LUMBER IN A MANNER TO BE DETERMINED BY THE PCA. 42

In addition to the foregoing, the PCA shall also, in coordination with
 the local government unit concerned, require the registration of all
 sawmills, lumberyards, coconut wood dealers and other persons or entities
 dealing in the processing [,] AND sawing of coconut trees."

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SEC. 5. Section 8 of Republic Act No. 8048, hereby renumbered as Section 9, is

6 hereby amended to read, as follows:

"SEC. [8]9. Penalties. – Those found guilty of violating this Act or any
rules and regulations issued pursuant hereto shall, upon conviction, be
punished by imprisonment of not less than [one (1) year] TWO (2) YEARS
but not more than six (6) years, or a fine of not less than [Fifty thousand
pesos (P50,000)] ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P100,000.00) but not
more than Five [h]Hundred [t]Thousand [p]Pesos (P500,000.00), or both,
[in] AT the discretion of the court.

if the offender is a corporation or a juridical entity, the official who
ordered or allowed the commission of the offense shall be punished with
the same penalty.

17 If the offender is in the government service, he shall, in addition be 18 dismissed from office.

UPON VERIFICATION BY THE PCA THAT NO REPLANTING WAS 19 DONE. THE BARANGAY CAPTAIN WHO ISSUED THE CERTIFICATION SHALL, 20 UPON CONVICTION, BE PENALIZED WITH IMPRISONMENT OF NOT LESS 21 THAN THREE (3) YEARS BUT NOT MORE THAN SEVEN (7) YEARS AND A 22 FINE OF NOT LESS THAN ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P100,000) BUT 23 NOT MORE THAN ONE MILLION PESOS (P1,000,000). FURTHERMORE, THE 24 BARANGAY CAPTAIN CONCERNED SHALL BE PERPETUALLY DISQUALIFIED 25 FROM HOLDING ANY OTHER PUBLIC OFFICE." 26

- 27 SEC. 6. The succeeding sections are hereby renumbered accordingly.
- 28 SEC. 7. Separability Clause. If any provision or part hereof is held invalid or
- 29 unconstitutional, the remainder of the law or the provisions not otherwise affected shall
- 30 remain valid and subsisting.
- 31 SEC. 8. Repealing Clause. All laws, issuances or parts thereof inconsistent with this
- 32 Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
- 33 SEC. 9. Effectivity Clause. This Act shall take effect after fifteen days from its
- 34 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
