EXPLANATORY NOTE

Race horse jockeys have to be always in tiptop shape. Their profession involves competing at breakneck speed and also undergoing strenuous activities with their mount outside of racing.

Under existing laws, the retirement age of racehorse jockeys is sixty years. But we all know that with age comes the physical deterioration of the mortal body. The jockey's accustomed alertness will fade, thus affecting his riding attitude. Given the physical demands and risks their profession entails, there is, therefore, a need to reduce the retirement age of racehorse lockeys.

In pursuance of better protection and promotion of adequate benefits for our racehorse jockeys, approval of this bill is earnestly sought.

AN ACT

AMENDING PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 442, AS AMENDED, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE LABOR CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES BY ADDING A NEW ARTICLE 287-A REDUCING THE RETIREMENT AGE OF RACE HORSE JOCKEYS FROM SIXTY (60) TO FIFTY-FIVE (55)

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Short Title. - This Act shall be known as "The Race Horse Jockeys Retirement Act of 2013".

SEC. 2. Retirement. - The Labor Code of the Philippines is hereby further amended by adding a new Article 287-A to read as follows:

"ART. 287-A. RETIREMENT AGE FOR RACE HORSE JOCKEYS. - A PROFESSIONAL RACE HORSE JOCKEY, WHO DULY LICENSED BY THE PHILIPPINE IS RACING COMMISSION (PHILRACOM), SHALL BE COMPULSORILY **RETIRED UPON REACHING THE AGE OF FIFTY-FIVE (55)** YEARS, AND SHALL BE ENTITLED TO ALL RETIREMENT **BENEFITS PROVIDED FOR UNDER ART. 287 OF THIS CODE.**

NOTHING IN THIS ARTICLE SHALL DEPRIVE ANY RACE HORSE JOCKEY OF THE BENEFITS HE IS ENTITLED TO UNDER EXISTING LAWS. COMPANY POLICIES OR PRACTICES."

SEC. 3. Implementing Rules and Regulations. - The Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), the Social Security System (SSS), the Philippine Racing Commission (PHILRACOM), and The New Philippine Jockeys Association, Inc. (TNPJAI) shall promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for the effective implementation of this Act within thirty (30) days from its effectivity.

SEC. 4. *Repealing Clause.* – All laws, decrees, executive orders, proclamations, rules and regulations, and other issuances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SEC. 5. *Effectivity Clause.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its complete publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
