## RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE PROPER SENATE COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE NEED TO STRENGTHEN THE REGULATION OF STEM CELL THERAPY IN THE COUNTRY

**WHEREAS**, it is the avowed policy of the State, as declared in *Article 2*, *Section 15 of the Constitution*, to protect and promote the right to health of the people;

**WHEREAS**, Stem Cell Therapy (the "Procedure") is a type of intervention strategy that introduces adult stem cells into damaged tissues to be able to treat a disease or injury;

**WHEREAS**, the Procedure has been proven beneficial in some medical conditions such as cancers of the blood and bone marrow, but is considered highly experimental in the treatment of other diseases;

**WHEREAS**, the Procedure became controversial after it was reported by the media that three (3) government officials allegedly died after going through the Procedure and another government official filed charges against a German doctor for his failed treatment;

**WHEREAS**, Stem Cell Therapy for unproven indications is proliferating in the Philippines and worse, said procedures are reported to be performed by unaccredited foreign doctors in five-star hotels;

**WHEREAS**, these uncontrolled practices are not only posing serious safety issues to unknowing clients, but also claiming the lives of our people;

**WHEREAS**, it is the duty of Congress to protect and uphold the right to health, and especially the right to life, of the Filipino people;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, BY THE PHILIPPINE SENATE TO DIRECT THE PROPER SENATE COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE NEED TO STRENGTHEN THE REGULATION OF STEM CELL THERAPY IN THE COUNTRY.
